Tricot Jersey for Doll Making

The double knit 100% natural cotton Jersey material comes in a loose or a tight stretch fabric.

The loose quality material is used for dolls for younger children. It is softer to the touch and thus, it is ideal for the tactile development of this age group.

The tight stretch material is mostly used for the larger dolls because it retains the shape of the doll during the stuffing process. It is also used for the faces of tiny dolls, e.g. the flower fairies, because the grain of the fabric will not spread as the face is shaped.

Four colours are available in both loose and tight:

1. Flesh
2. Koala
3. Chocolate
4. Navaho
